- Lessons Learned from a Nursing Home Evacuation in Massachusetts
- Overview of the 2019 Annual Disaster Exercise

The Afternoon Session will include a Tabletop Exercise.* Completion of the Table Top Exercise will include an After Action Report and Improvement Plan for your facility. All attendees should bring a copy of their Emergency Management Plan to use during the Tabletop Exercise.

*Tabletop Exercise will assist nursing homes in meeting the CMS Emergency Preparedness regulations for Testing.
