MassMAP LTC Coordinating Center Responder Recruitment

Background:

The last few years have been very active years for disasters affecting healthcare. We have seen rapid evacuations from the wildfires in California, flooding in Texas, as well as large-scale evacuations in Florida, Georgia, and Alabama. When Irma, a Category 4 hurricane, reached landfall on the west coast of Florida, it became very clear that if a hurricane of this magnitude struck the Commonwealth, MassMAP plan members would need to be supported for days. Realizing this would be a challenging task, the MassMAP response plan was revised in 2018.

To better operationalize MassMAP to support a long duration event, the plan was revised to:

- Expand response capabilities by developing Regional/Statewide Response Teams that:
 - Support a region response
 - Have the capability to function as a statewide team & support other states, if necessary, during a disaster.

Objectives of the MassMAP Response Team (RT):

- Support a MassMAP member in need of assistance by coordinating supplies, equipment, staffing, and supporting a facility evacuation (LTC Coordinating Center Operations) by finding appropriate open beds, available transportation resources, and tracking all resident movement.
- Maintain 100% accountability for all MassMAP facilities if they are experiencing operational issues from a community event such as a snowstorm, hurricane, or tornado.
- RT members are fluent in the use of the MassMAP website, specifically in the use of the Emergency Reporting Dashboard and the development of Operational Summary Reports for community partners.
- Attend (2) two of the (3) three annual training sessions and attend the annual exercise. The total commitment is (3) three onsite sessions per year.
