


► Updating Categories of Care & Downloading the Categories of Care Report for Choosing Evacuation Sites

► Step 1: Login in to MAP

Once logged in, go to your facility page and choose the 3rd tab called LTC Beds. Check off each category of care offered at your facility. Review and edit total # of beds and Surge Capacity notes. When done make sure to choose Save Changes.

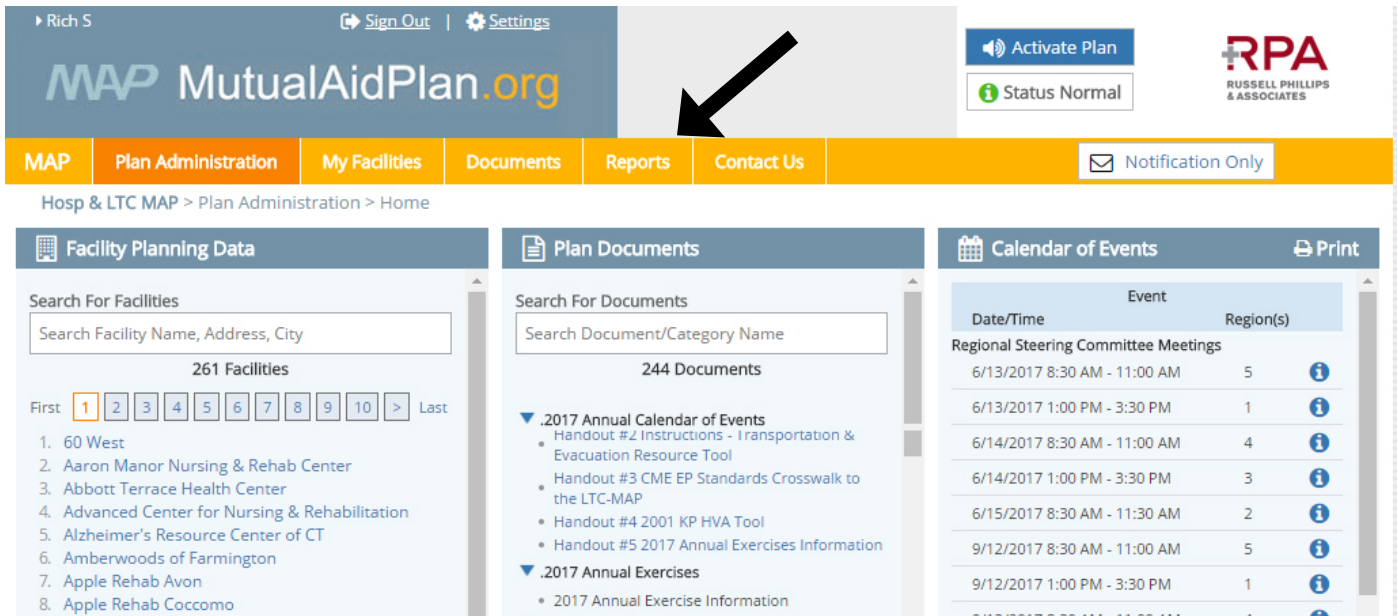

Step 2: Go to Reports

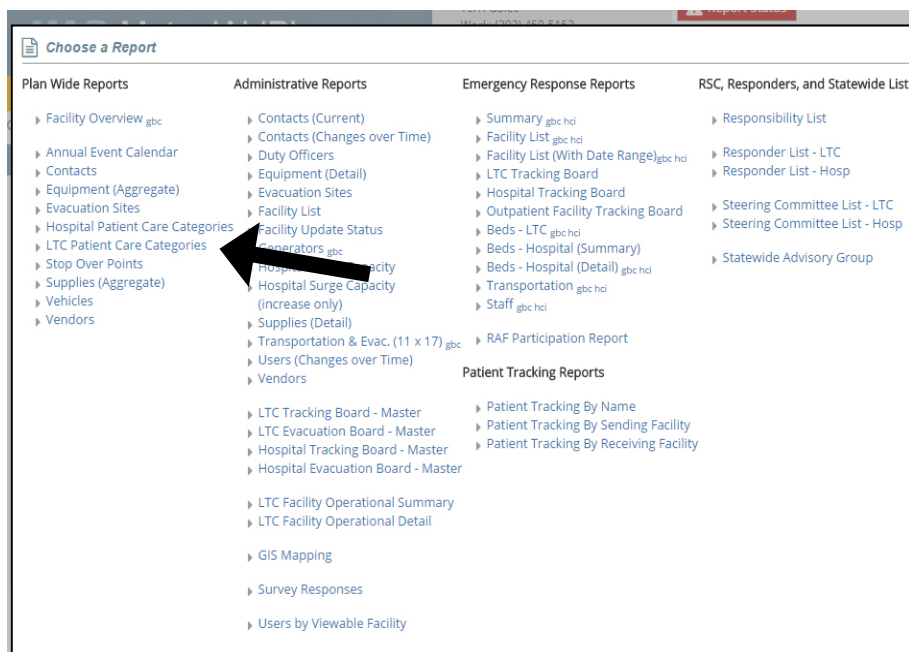
To assist you in identifying what facilities provide the same level of care as your facility and can accept your residents during an evacuation, go to your Home page, and click on Reports.



Step 3: Choose LTC Patient Care Categories

After clicking the link, on the next “pop-up” screen, choose your Region and Facility Type. We recommend opening the file in MS Excel, as it will allow you to customize the data.

*Note: you should have 10 evacuation sites listed, with one of those being >50 miles away.
